Since Shelter Movers first took root in 2016, our volunteers and staff have supported hundreds of families who did not need to plan their move, bear the cost of storage or face the very real risk of further violence when deciding whether or not to flee their abuser. I know all too well from my work in a women's shelter that healing from trauma is relational. It comes from knowing you are not alone, that you are cared for, and that you are part of a community.
